Warehouse operations


- Large scale pallet size donations

Our 2023 Impact



374 volunteers spent 5,789 hours making food move across our eight operating regions - three of which only launched in August 2023.




Food from 269 food donors was delivered to 304 unique service agencies - providing an estimated 954,613 meals!



We rescued 1,057,867 pounds of good food which translates to 1,470,426 pounds of GHG emissions prevented.

What makes us unique?

We mobilize community to help offset the labor hours, cost, and logistics associated with acquiring food donations for our community service agencies.







All food rescue organizations are working on different aspects of a complex problem. For example:

- Many Food Banks have the infrastructure to pick up large donations from bigger retailers.
- Second Harvest creates a network for other large retailers to post donations in an app for well-resourced service agencies to claim and pick up themselves
- To Good to Go is a way for smaller retailers who operate within narrow margins to recoup costs

Where does Leftovers fit?

Leftovers engages volunteers to collect small and medium donations of good edible food from vendors who don't fit into other programs and redirect that food to service agencies without the resources to pick up donated food themselves.
